




The international investment situation is very favorable, with numerous capacity projects across all continents, perhaps even more in North America, the Middle East and Eastern Europe. The objective of feeding growing populations is tangible reality. A large portion of these investments focuses on baking industry products similar to bread or their regional equivalents. Projects related to viennoiseries and American pastries are also following this trend.



In France, the situation is mixed. It is clear that the overall atmosphere is not very positive and that, in general, investments are not materializing. The trend initiated after the end of COVID to relaunched prebudgeting studies continues, but unfortunately, few major projects are coming to an end. However, some projects are being realized or are currently underway. They are mainly driven by major industry players, but not exclusively. A significant part of these projects concern soft bread (buns, sandwich bread, brioche), viennoiseries, and pastries.
